International Journal of Computer Science and Engineering (IJCSE)

1. Submission Requirements

Submission of an article to IJCSE implies the following:

Originality: The work described has not been published previously (except in the form of an abstract, part of a published lecture, or academic thesis).

Exclusivity: The manuscript is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.

Approval: Its publication is approved by all authors and tacitly or explicitly by the authorities responsible where the work was carried out.

Preprint Policy: We accept submissions that have previously appeared on preprint servers (e.g., arXiv, bioRxiv, SSRN); have been presented at conferences; or appeared in other “non-journal” venues (e.g., academic blogs or posters). Authors are responsible for updating the archived preprint with the journal reference (including DOI) upon publication.

2. Copyrights and Permissions

Author Ownership: Copyrights for articles are retained by the authors, with first publication rights granted to IJCSE.

Reuse Rights: Authors have rights to reuse, republish, archive, and distribute their own articles after publication.

Indexing: Authors permit the publisher to apply a DOI to their articles and to archive them in global databases and indexes such as Crossref and Google Scholar.

3. Plagiarism Policy

IJCSE maintains a zero-tolerance plagiarism policy. Every submission is screened using professional plagiarism prevention tools (**iThenticate/CrossCheck**) before

being sent for peer review. Any manuscript containing plagiarized material or falsified data will be rejected immediately.

4. Manuscript Preparation

Format: Manuscripts should be prepared in **Microsoft Word** (.doc or .docx) format.

Submission: All contributions must be submitted through the **Online Submission System** on our official website.

Editing: The editors reserve the right to edit contributions for clarity and style, but authors will receive final proofs for approval before publication.

Paper Selection and Publication Process

Step 1: Submission Acknowledgement An automated "Submission Acknowledgement" email will be sent immediately upon online submission. For manual inquiries, our editorial assistants will provide confirmation within 1-2 working days.

Step 2: Basic Review & Plagiarism Check The editor evaluates the manuscript for fit within the journal's aim and scope. The similarity index is then verified via iThenticate.

Step 3: Double-Blind Peer Review We utilize a double-blind system: both reviewers and authors remain anonymous. Each paper is evaluated by at least three experts (one internal editor and two external reviewers). The review process typically takes **2-4 weeks**.

Step 4: Acceptance/Rejection Decision Decisions are based on reviewer recommendations. If opinions conflict, the Editor-in-Chief will make the final decision or initiate a second round of review.

Step 5: Notification The corresponding author will be notified of the review results and the editorial decision via email.

Step 6: Revision and Article Processing Charge (APC) Authors must revise the manuscript based on feedback. As a Gold Open Access journal, IJCSE charges an **Article Publication Fee (APC)**. This fee covers typesetting, DOI registration, plagiarism checking, and maintaining the platform for free global access. *(Note: To support the research community, IJCSE may offer APC waivers for high-quality submissions during the 2026 inaugural period.)*

Step 7: Online First Publication Accepted and processed manuscripts will be published online immediately to ensure rapid dissemination of research.

Step 8: Post-publication The online PDF version is free to access and download. Authors are encouraged to promote their work through institutional repositories.
